1. Intrusion of Sin



MJ and Peter in park (garden of Eden).

Original Sin as alien, not a part of God's plan.

We start out unaware of our sinful nature.

We all are susceptible to temptation and sin.

2. Free Will



Freedom to choose is a powerful gift.

3. Sin Changes US



- a. loss of innocence

- c. vengeance
- d. loss of identity: Who are you? I dont know.

4. Shame and Conscience
